Tumble Wines embraces the freedom of not being tied down by roots. They focus on producing craft wines from small parcels of fruit sourced from single vineyards that they have a hand in managing from start to finish. Without the constraints of owning land or a brick and mortar winery, Tumble Wines is able to roll with the wind and create something new every vintage.

A bit more about the vineyards that make Tumble Wines....

Sandbar Vineyard- South East Kelowna

Tumble Wines has leased this land continuously since 2019 when it produced its first Riesling from this site. Further plantings of Riesling are anticipated to fill in gaps in the current acreage and there is potential to expand a lower 2.5 acre portion of land with Pinot Noir and Riesling plantings in 2021.

Cactus Crescent Vineyard- Osoyoos Lake District

Wines from this site produced so far are 2018 Wind Blown White (a field blend of Chardonnay, Viogner, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat) and future plans include a Pinot Noir Rose, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir wines. In 2021 the team is looking at grafting or replanting odd varieties to focus on Pinot Noir and Chardonnay at this site.

Clearbrook Vineyard- Fraser Valley

Prior to the inception of Tumble Wines, this vineyard was leased out to another Fraser Valley Winery with multiple award winning vintages. In 2019, Tumble Wines jumped at the chance to manage this site and is working with the original owners to produce their own Wine Label "Clearbrook Vineyards" in addition to adding Siegerrebe to the Tumble Wines Portfolio.
